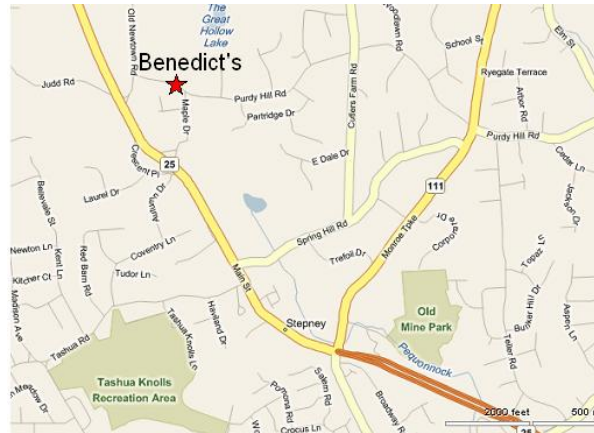

Why should I seal my driveway?

Sealing your driveway is important because doing so preserves the asphalt and just makes your driveway look better in general. When your driveway is properly maintained, other tasks involving it, such as cleaning it, plowing or shoveling snow off of it, etc. are made much easier because the surface is much smoother.

Do I need to prepare my driveway before I seal it?

It is very important that before you seal your driveway, you take the time to clean it thoroughly. You should first remove any dirt and debris on the driveway; sweeping or using a leaf blower would be an excellent idea. After this, it would be a good idea to use a driveway cleaner and degreaser on your driveway to insure that there are no grease or oil spots on it that will interfere with proper sealing.
