

How do I get lawn fungus?

Lawn fungus generally occurs because of moist, stagnant conditions. It is easier to prevent fungus than it is to cure fungus. If your lawn is susceptible to fungus or has had fungus in years past, chances are that it will reoccur. Fungus can occur at anytime of the year, but usually occurs during wet or humid periods. The most common fungi that can occur in lawns are dollar spot, red thread, and brown patch.



How do I take care of it?

We recommend using Bayer Lawn Fungus Control to cure and prevent any lawn fungus problems you may have or wish to prevent. This product is granular, and when spread and watered in enters the root system of your lawn so that it can not be washed off (this is called “systemic”). In order to treat a disease that you already have on your lawn, be sure to apply it at the first sign of the disease to ensure maximum effectiveness. To prevent any future fungus from infecting your lawn, make your first application right before any hot, humid weather.

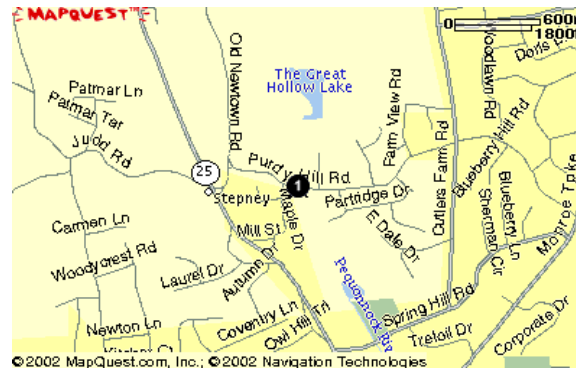
A general rule of thumb is that in order to cure lawn fungus, you will have to apply two to three times the amount of fungus control, whereas a preventative use needs to only be applied once.
